About Opportunity Shuttles:

Opportunity Shuttles are a regularly scheduled bus service offered by NEICAC –Transit. The shuttles connect people to different towns to allow for affordable access to expanded medical, social and retail opportunities. Opportunity Shuttles are also in place to help students get to and from the area during college breaks and to help low-income citizens get to the Regional Housing Authority to apply for services.



All Opportunity Shuttles are open to the public and can be used for any purpose.

Housing Service Shuttle

NEICAC - Transit has partnered with the Upper Explorerland Regional Planning Commission (UERPC) Housing Inc. Board to create the **Housing Service Opportunity Shuttle**.

This shuttle gives people affordable transportation to the UERPC offices in Postville, IA to apply for services. **The shuttle can be used for other purposes as well.**

Details of the Housing Service Shuttle:

- This service runs the **second Monday of each month**.
- This shuttle currently offers service between **Oelwein and Postville** and included stops in **Maynard, Fayette, West Union, and Clermont, Iowa** upon request.
- **Reservations are required.**
Call 1-866-382-4259 to schedule a ride.
- The cost is **\$3 per one way ride**
- Payment is required at the time of service. Exact fare is needed. Drivers accept check, cash or NEICAC tickets.
- **Designated stops are set in each of the communities served.** If you need a ride to one of the shuttle stops, other NEICAC-Transit services can be used. Call or check the website to learn more.
- Reservations can be made to get on or off at any of the scheduled stops.
- Additional service areas may be added in the future. Check the NEICAC-Transit website for up-to-date information.

The below chart lists the Shuttle times and stop locations. **Please note:** The bus will only stop if reservations have been made—the bus does not stop automatically.
